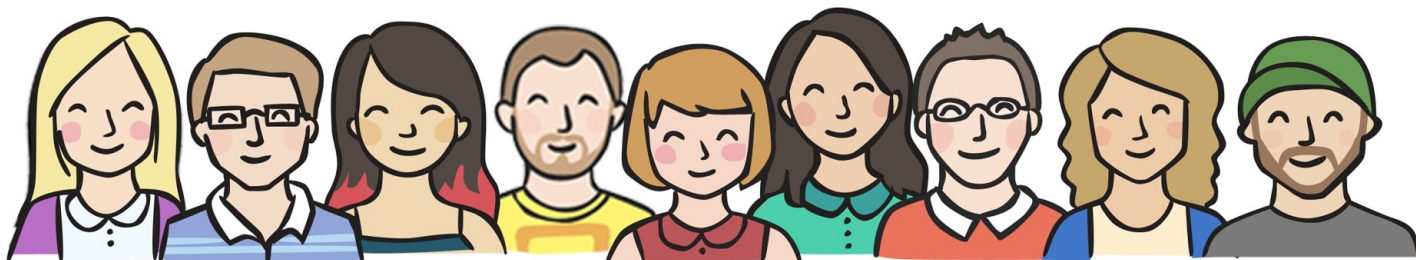

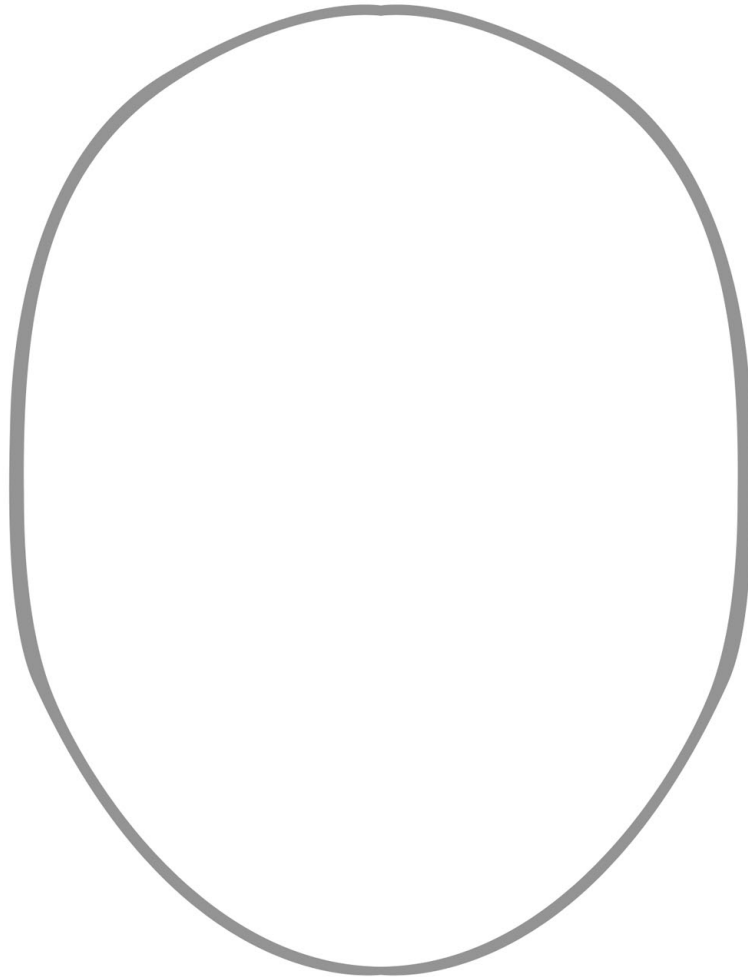
How to Draw a Portrait

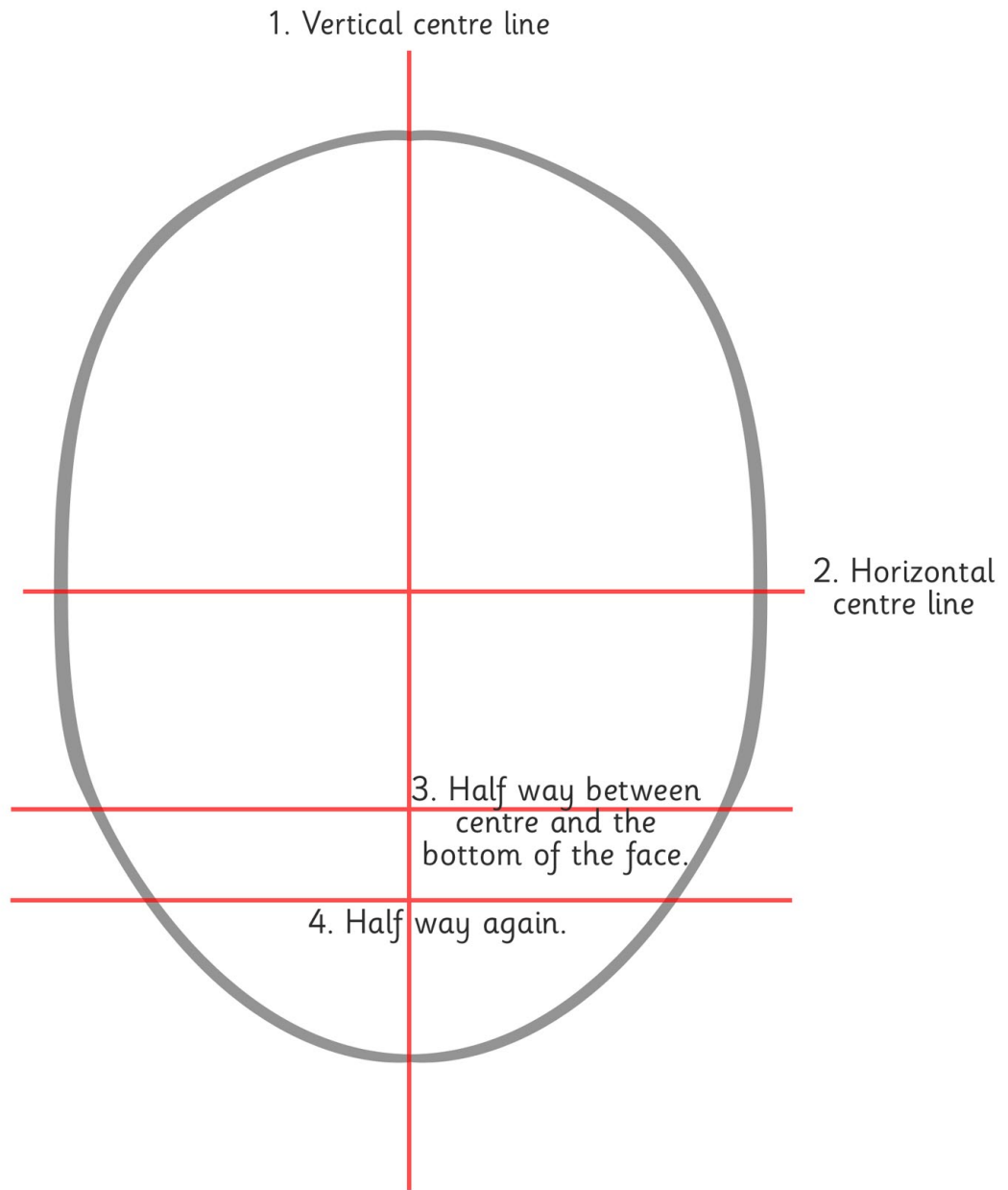
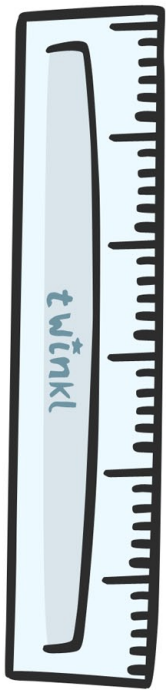

Draw a faint oval. You will go back over this later after you have drawn the hair.

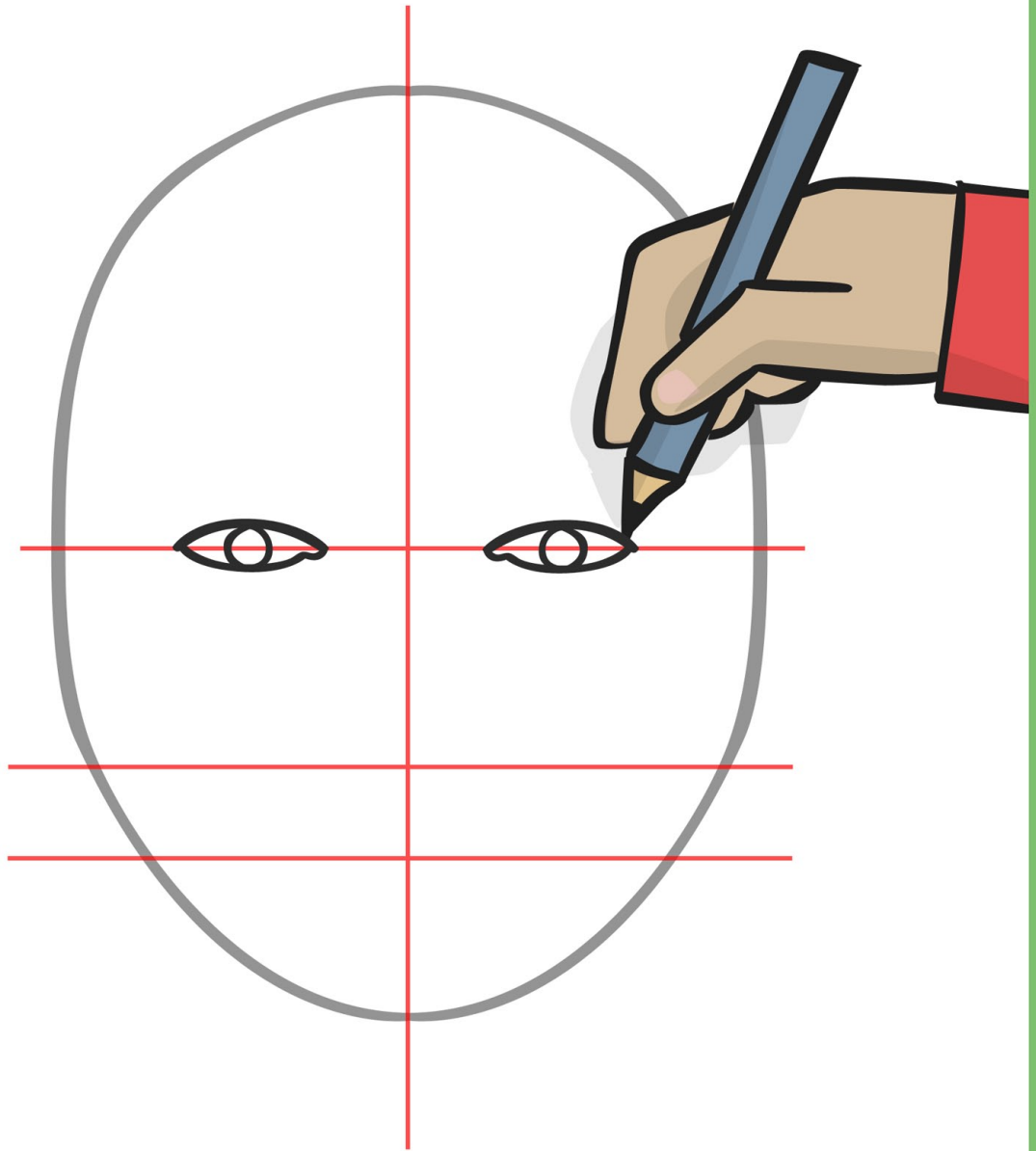

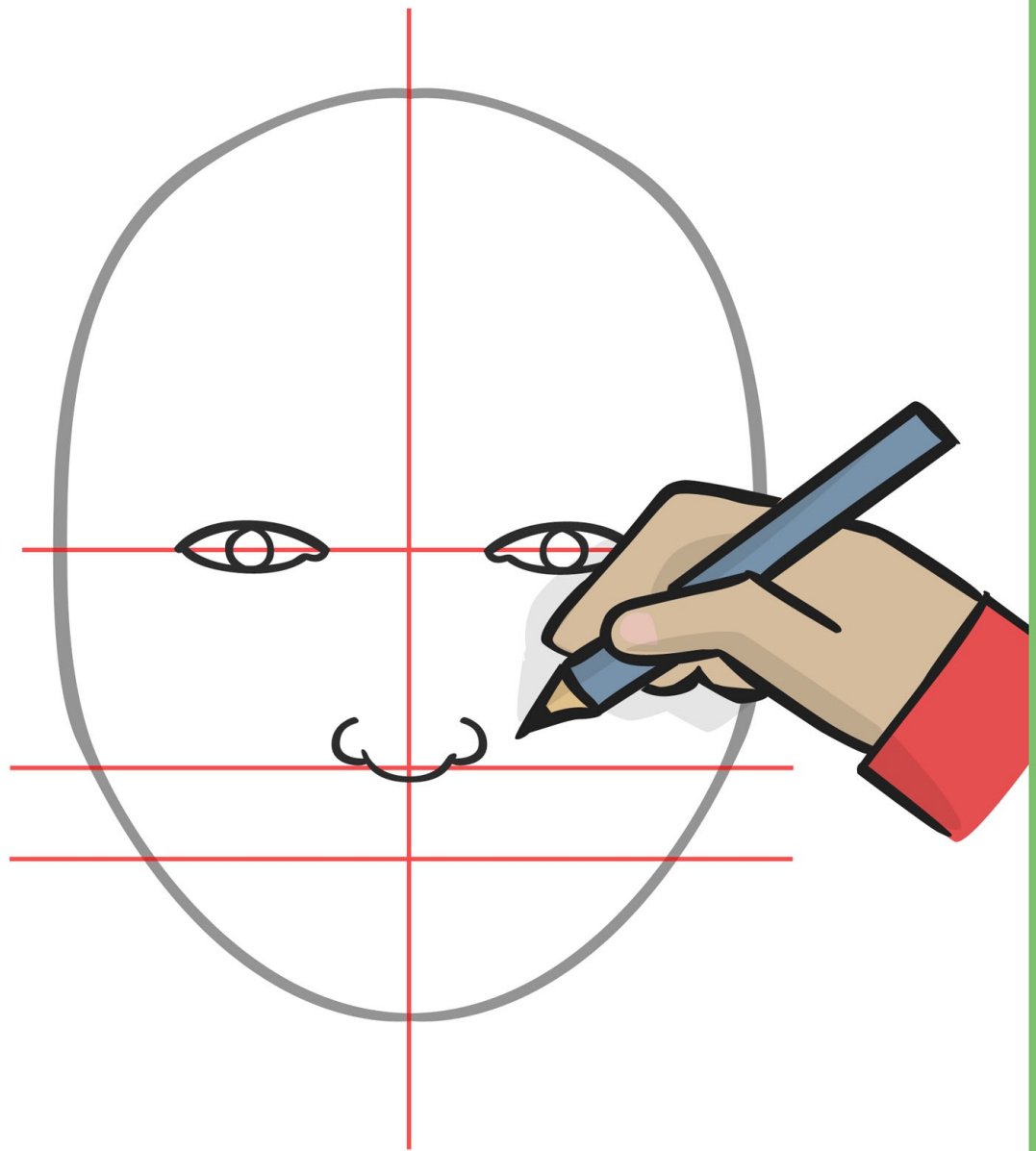
Mark some very faint guide lines with a pencil and ruler.

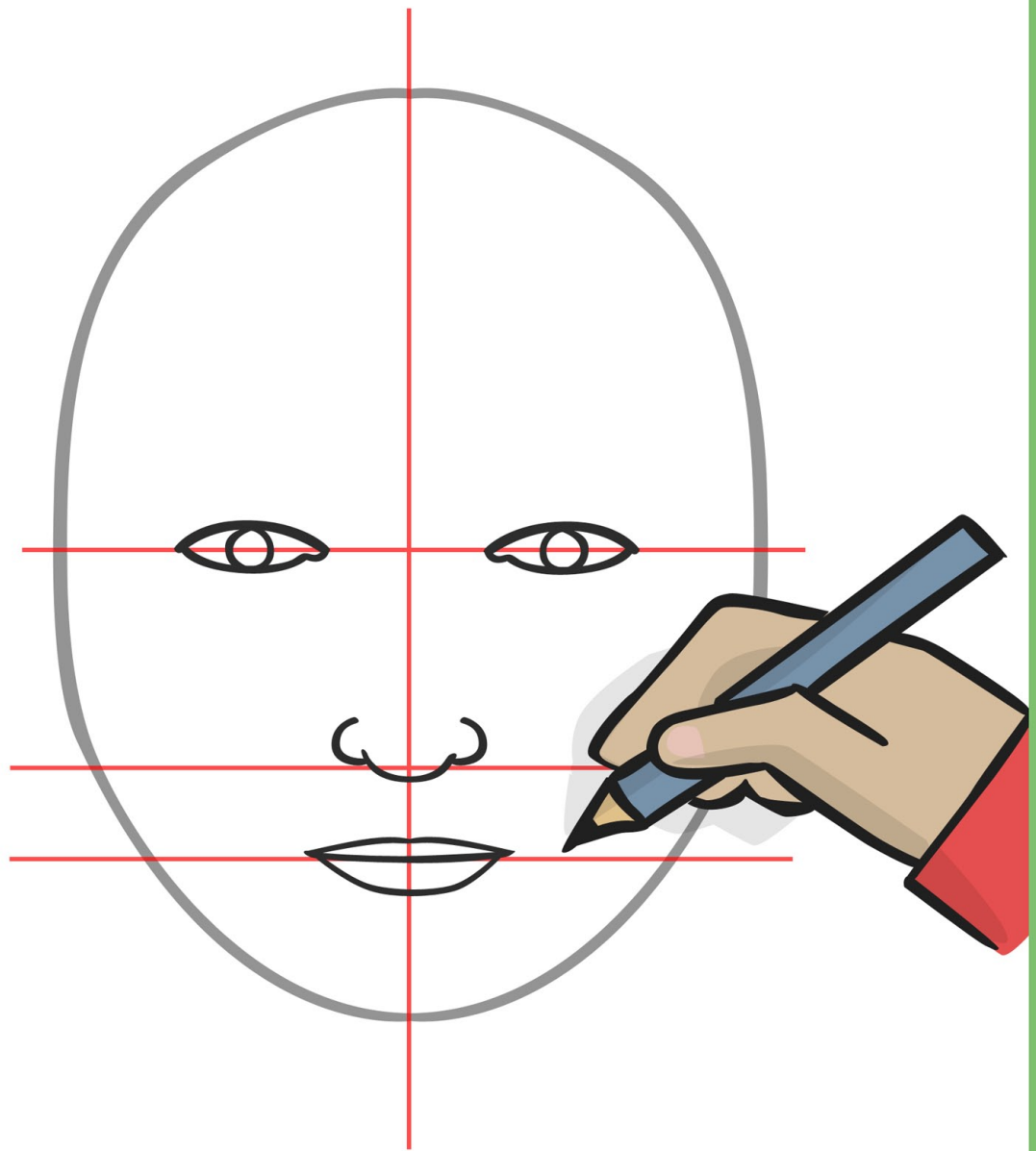
Draw the eyes.

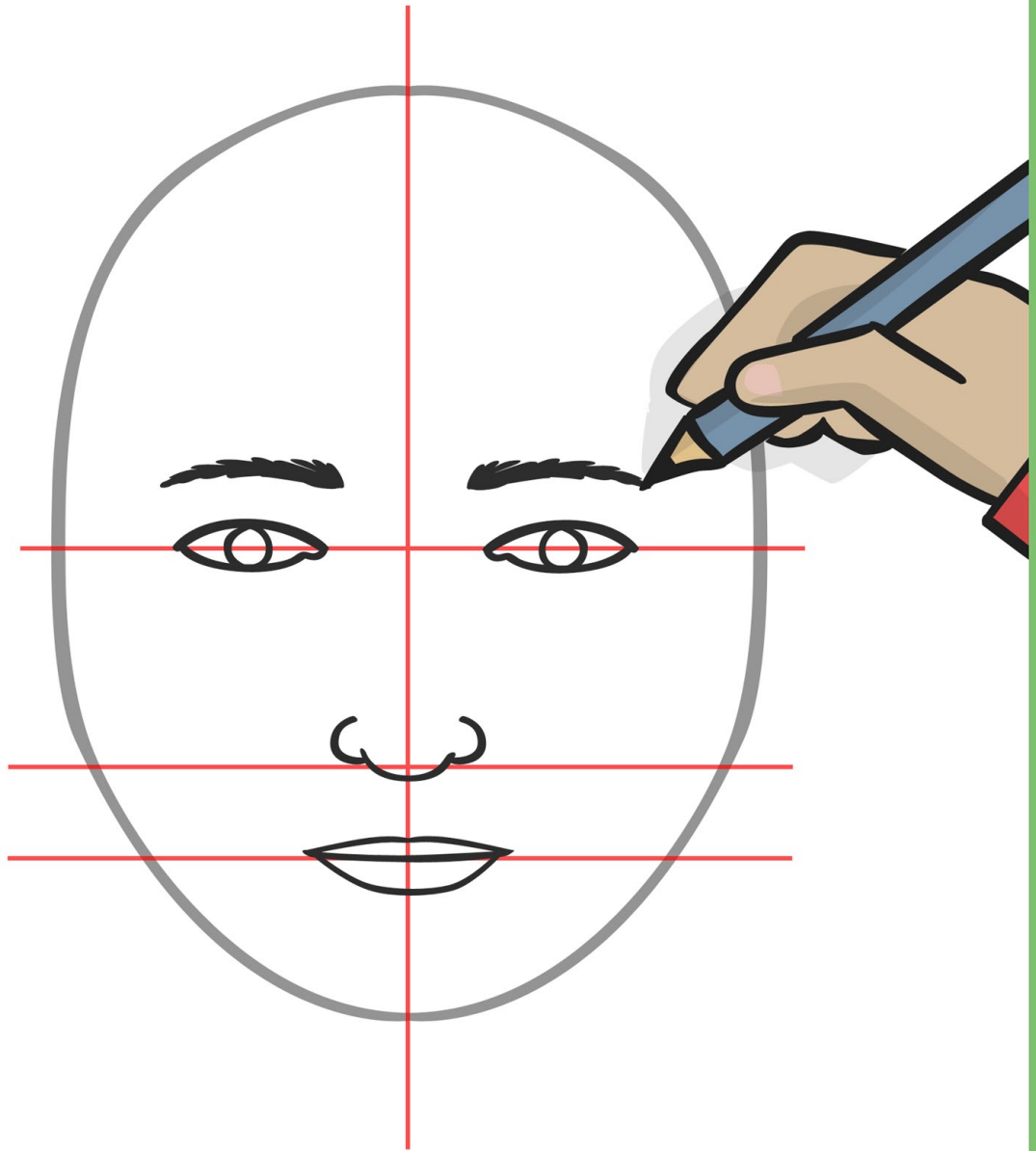
Draw the nose.

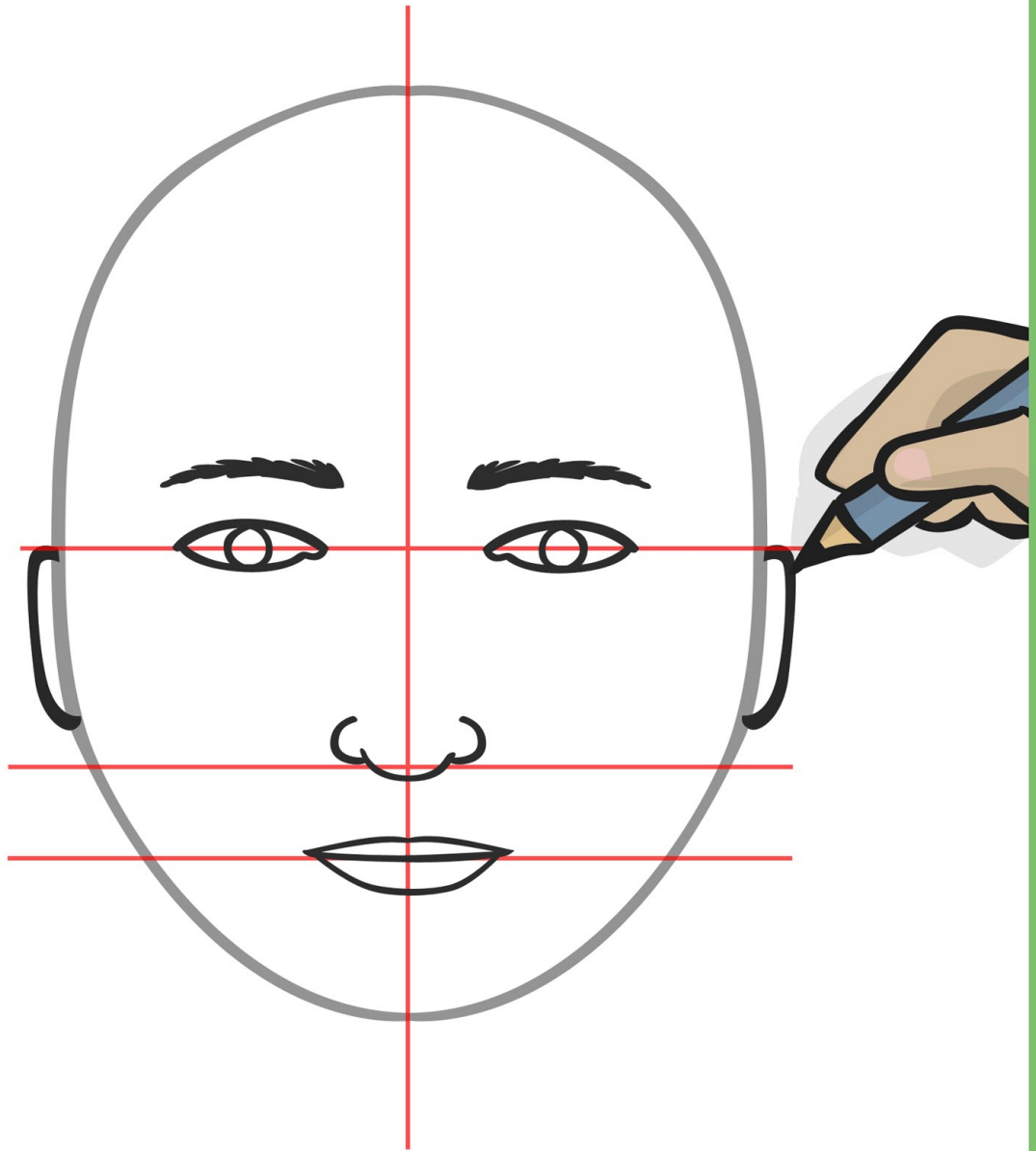
Draw the mouth.

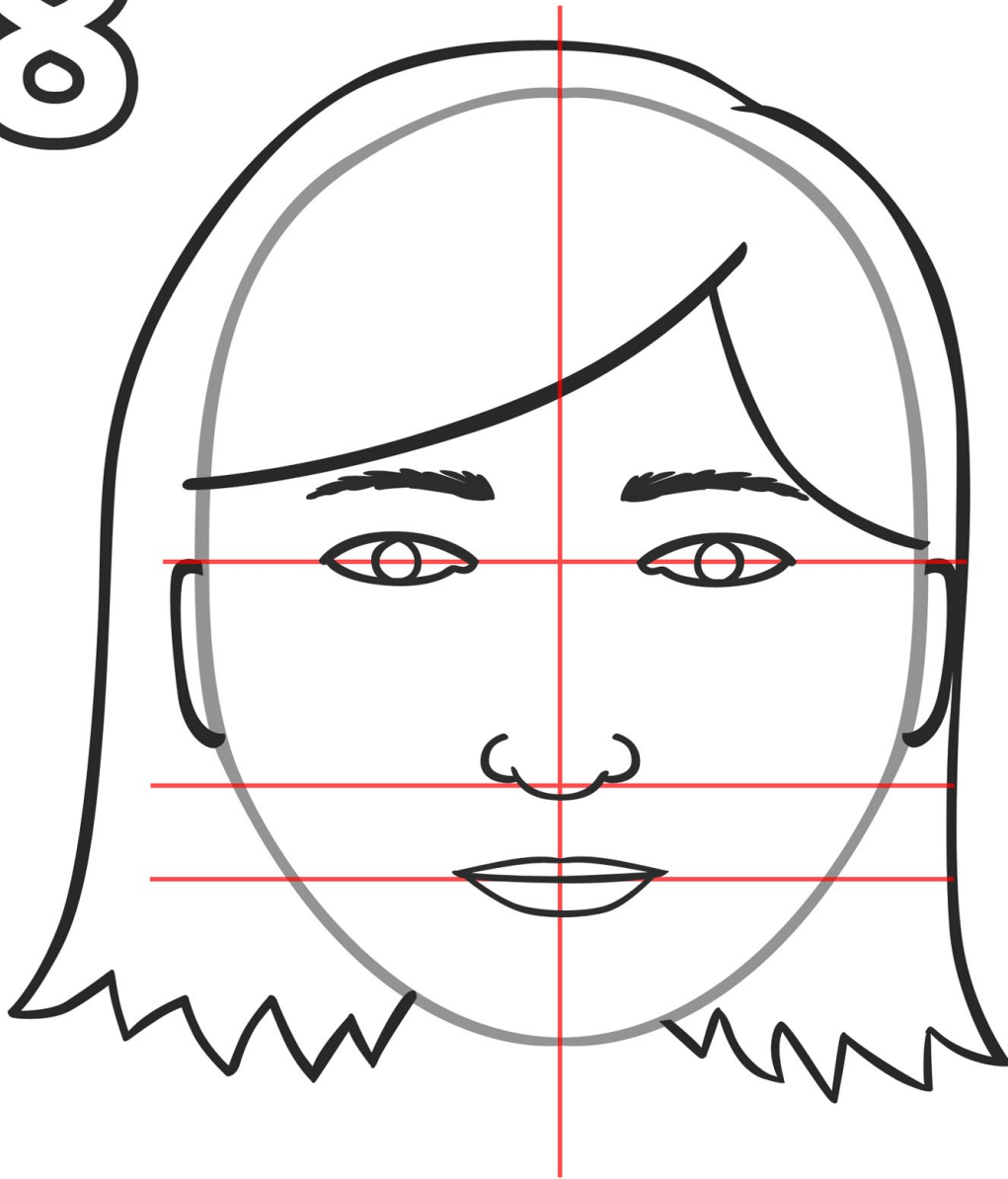
Draw the eyebrows.

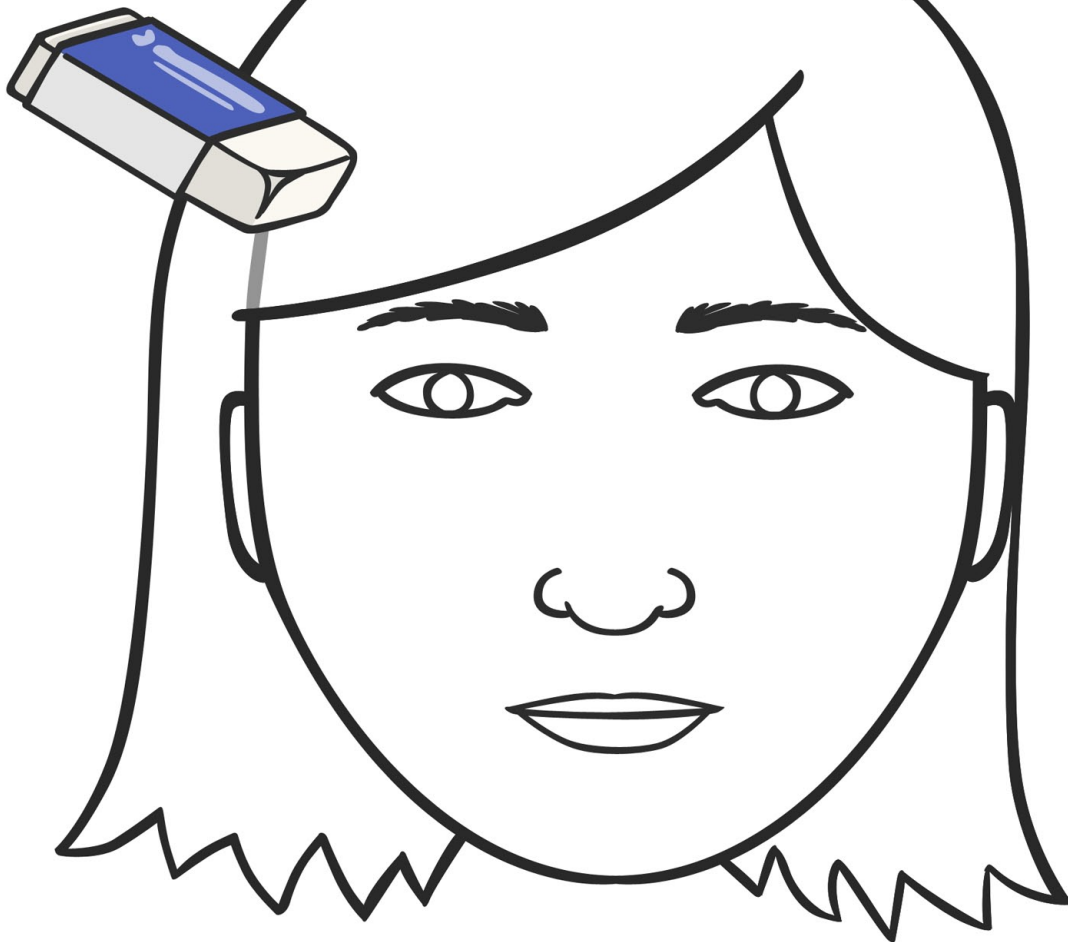
Draw the ears.

Draw the hair.

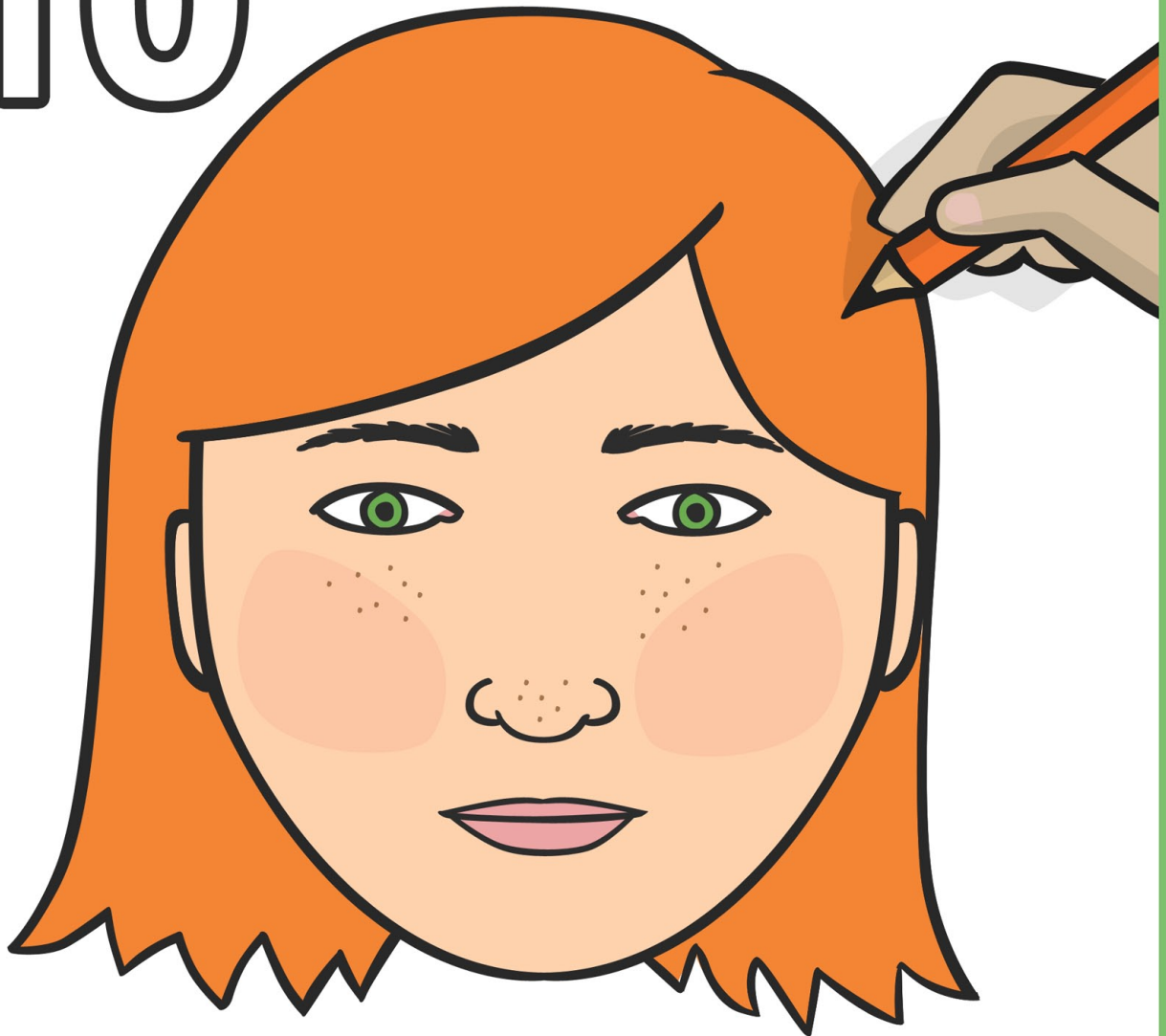
