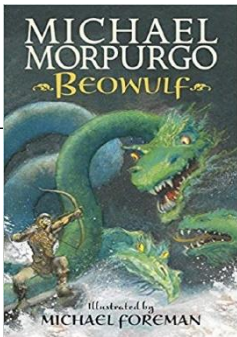


English

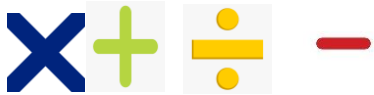
