

Home Learning – Sparrows Week Seven

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Discuss working together and remember a time when you last helped.

The last character in the story was the smallest but helped pull up the turnip. Discuss how little things can make a big difference.

Literacy

Read 'The Enormous Turnip' or watch a version on YouTube. There are lots of different versions of this story! Compare 2 versions – how are they the same? How are they different?

Create a page from your own version of the story, you could change the vegetable or some of the characters.

Understanding the World

How do turnips grow? Which countries do they grow in?

Make and taste soup or stew containing turnip.

Talk about the forces in the story – pushes and pulls. Look at where we might use these ourselves. There are resources on Twinkl to help with this if you'd like.

Phonics

Maths

Use your soft toys and teddies to create your own line of helpers to pull out the Enormous Turnip.

Can you use ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th) to describe where in the line each teddy/toy is standing?

Problem solve sequences of numbers on the turnips on the worksheet. What number comes next in the sequence? Try to explain how you solved the answer.

Describe and name the shape and size the turnip is (sphere, curved, round, long, etc). Use a selection of fruit and vegetables to play a guessing game. Give clues to another person about your vegetable /fruit using shape and size words to describe it. Did they guess your Fruit/vegetable?
