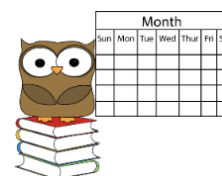
This month's recipe is Lentil Dahl and is delicious and very easy to cook. Please see the attachment for the recipe.
