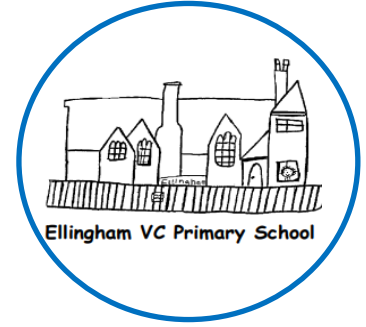

25th March

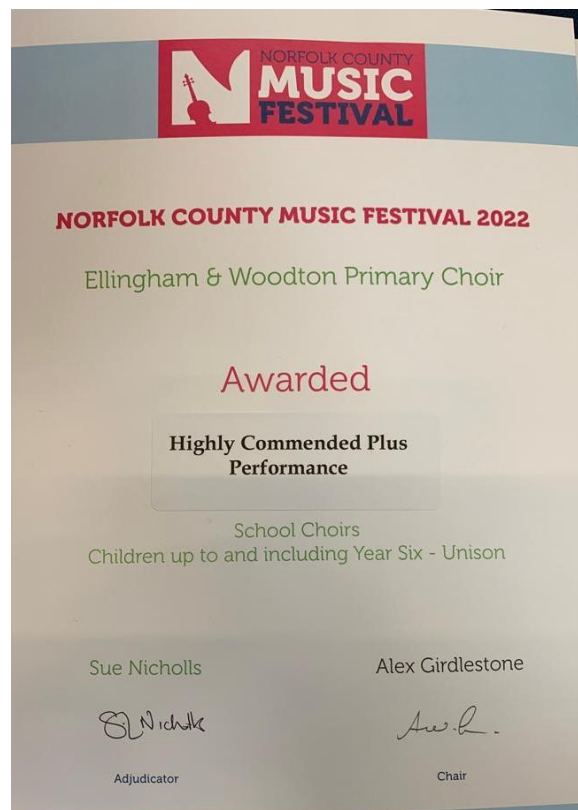
On Friday 25th March the PTA are having a non uniform in return for a boxed Easter Egg. This is for the Easter Bingo on Friday 1st April - See below for information.



Norfolk Music Festival

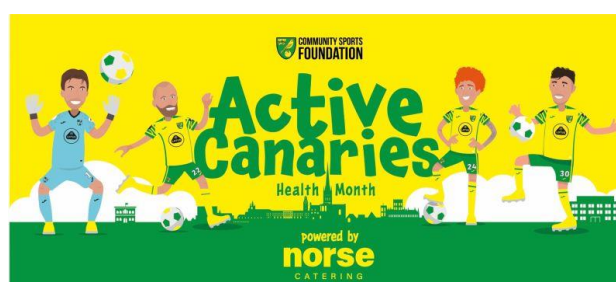

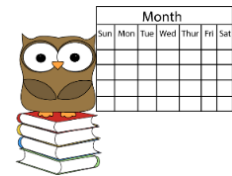
