Friday 11th March - Fruit Kebab Friday

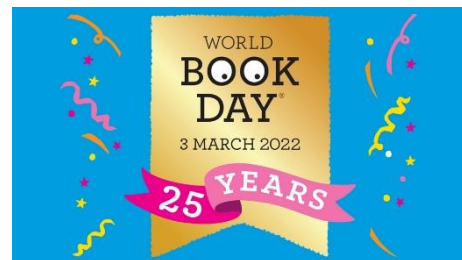

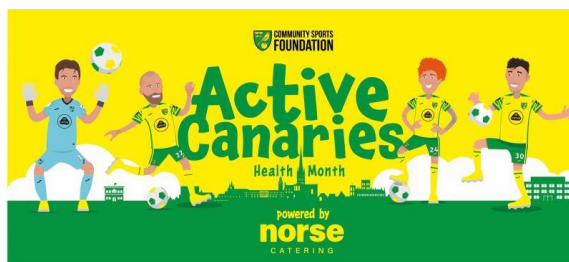
Parent's Evening

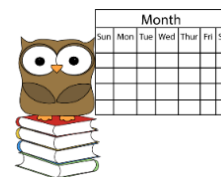
