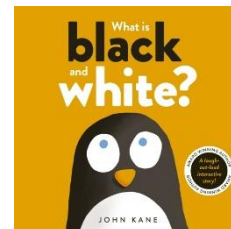
There will be an eco committee meeting on Swallows classroom on Friday 15th March at lunchtime.

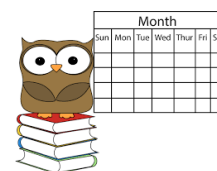
