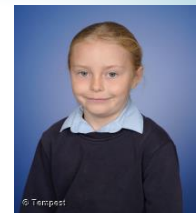
## This Week's Achievements

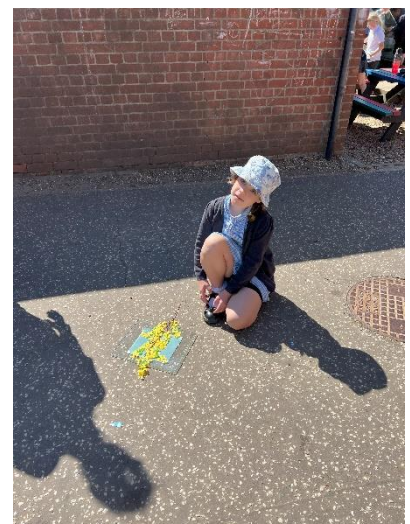




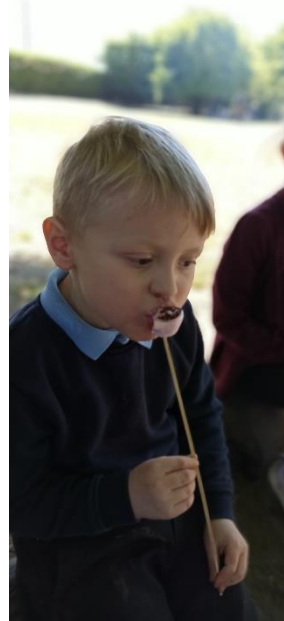
## News & Dates

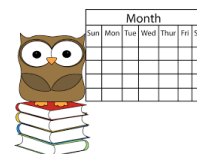
