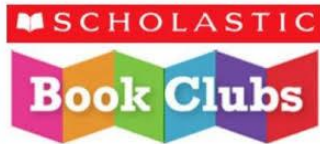

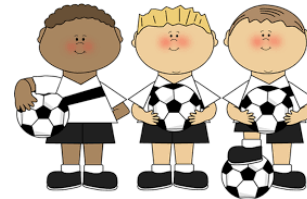

Before the games could be totalled, Woodton and Ellingham Primary needed to have one last game with each other, which they done this Monday. Final scores will be announced soon.



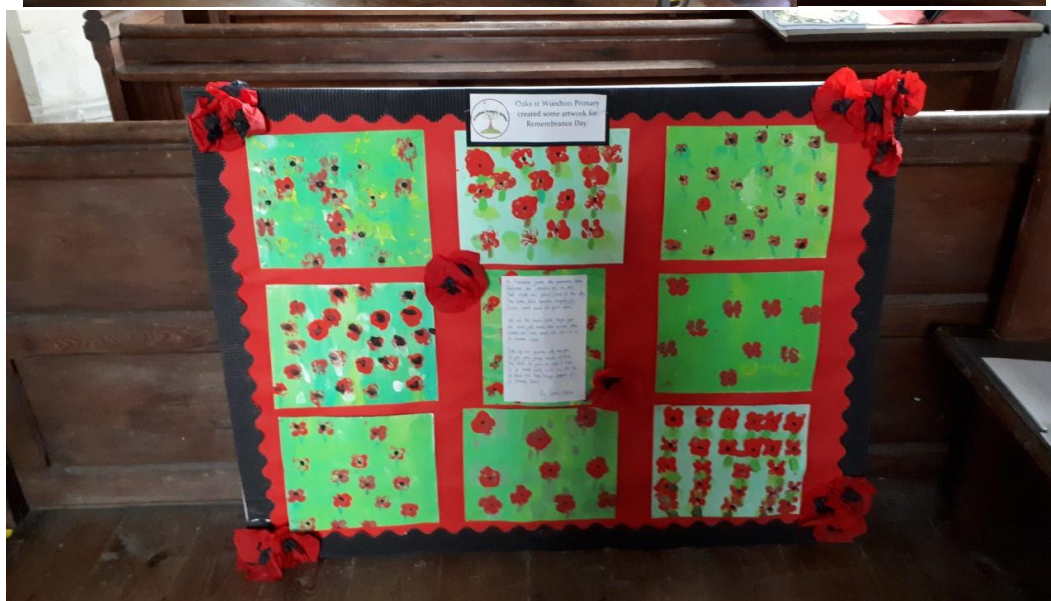
Swimming Gala
