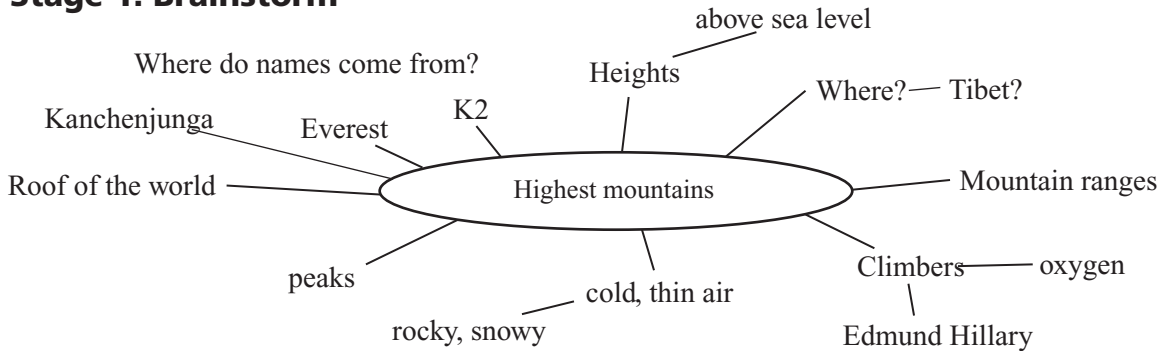


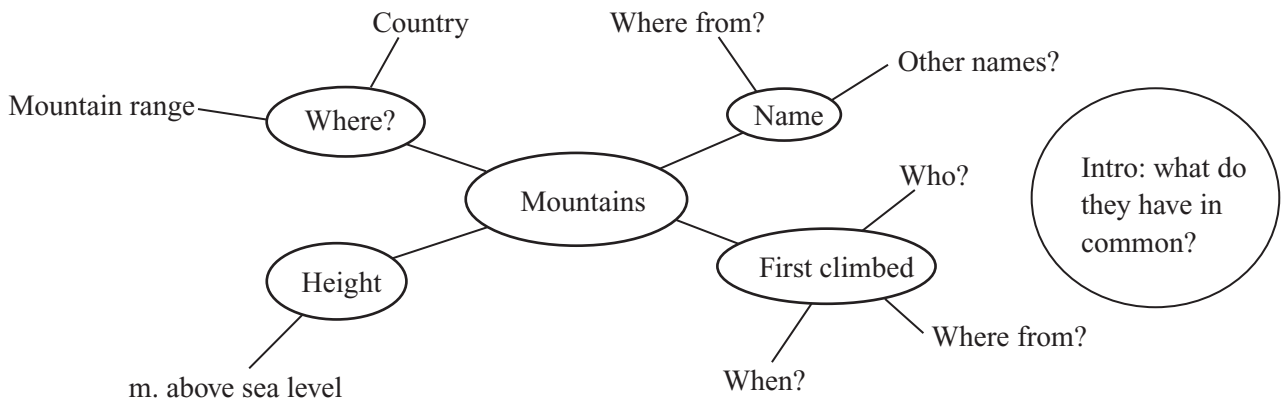

<b>Where?</b>	Asia — roof of world Nepal/China Himalaya range	Asia — roof of world North Pakistan Karakhoram range	Asia — roof of world Nepal/Tibet Himalaya range
<b>Name</b>	Sir George Everest — 1850s (surveyor) Chinese — Qomolangma Nepalese — Sagarmatha	Second of K range to be measured	Tibetan — 'five treasures of the snow' (five peaks)
<b>First climbed</b>	1953 Edmund Hillary (New Zealand) Tenzing Norgay (Nepal)	1954 Italian team	1955 British team — not summit — local religion
