## Norfolk Directory

Norfolk's Local Offer Website has over 300 pages of information and an online database called the Norfolk Directory, which has over 5000 providers of services, support and advice. You can either search the directory by keyword and / or postcode or by searching through categories of services such as:

- Childcare and out of school activities
- Parenting and family support
- Health and wellbeing
- Education, training and employment.

The results can then be filtered further using filters such as age, supported condition and whether they are part of the Local Offer. Results can also be printed, emailed or placed into a shopping basket (shortlist). The Norfolk Directory can be found on the Local Offer main page.
