

Maths Whizz



This week we have carried out a number of assessment activities including: converting measurements to different units e.g. 423 cms = 4.23 m = 0.00423 kms, finding the perimeters and areas of rectangles and composite shapes (Red group used the formula πr^2 to find the area of circles), dividing decimal numbers and adding and subtracting fractions.

Literacy

In literacy we have continued with our Science Fiction stories, concentrating on flashbacks and cliff-hangers, and thinking particularly about using cohesive devices to make it flow.
