Our work with Adnams has started this week and we're all raring to go. The children have been asked to bring in a large plastic fizzy drinks bottle for next week's session.



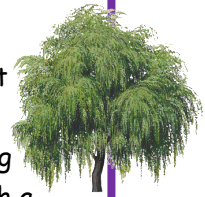
As part of the Food for Thought project the children have created their own business called "Vege-Tales" and would appreciate it if you could donate any of the following:
