Maths: We are using the empty number line for addition and subtraction and investigating ratio and proportion.



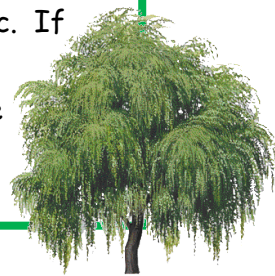
Adnams
