

<u>English</u>

In our writing we have been working on information texts. We have used books and the internet to research an area of the Tudors and have learnt about the main features of non-fiction information texts.

Maths

This week in our maths we have been working on times tables and multiplication. The Triangles and Squares have been working on learning their 3,4,6 and 8 times tables and the division facts that go with them. The Pentagons and Hexagons are continued to work on multiplying three numbers together and have worked on written methods to multiply 2 and 3 digit numbers by a 1 digit number.
