GDPR - General Data Protection Regulation

A reminder that there are new regulations coming in to force in May 2018. **GDPR** is a regulation that requires businesses to protect the personal data and privacy of individuals. This is a statutory requirement. Therefore, you may see some changes in our policies and procedures in the coming months. Please understand that any changes are put into place to protect yours and your children's data.

One of these changes is that we will no longer send out newsletters by email to any **business email address**. Therefore if you currently have a business address listed, please provide an alternative personal email address. If you cannot provide a personal email address then we can arrange to send you a paper copy of the newsletter home with your child.

A reminder as well that parents/carers **should not be coming back into school after clubs**. Any item left in school can be collected the next day.



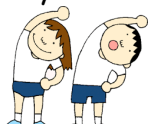
Important:
