

Maths

This week in maths we have worked on multiplication and division. The Pentagons and Hexagons groups have worked really hard on multiplying 2 and 3 digit numbers and have learnt how to use long multiplication to do this. They have all been brilliant at this and learnt a lot.

The Triangles and Squares have done grid multiplication and division by repeated addition. These two groups have made loads of progress this week and are quickly turning into maths geniuses.

English

In literacy we have been writing instruction leaflets on how to look after animals. For example, 'How to look after a Polar Bear'. We have had a lot of fun thinking of ways to keep our wild animals happy and how to feed and clean them. Next week we will write them in neat and make them look amazing.




