The first 3 months of 2018 have proved extremely busy for the charity. Local authority EHCP deadlines in February and March brought a flurry of Final Plans to parents, so we have had lots of enquiries from parents looking for support and advice with their child's Plan.

We have had 50 calls to the helpline since the start of the year, and 8 new members since January.

Training Days for Parents / Carers

In March we also held the first of our 4 training sessions on EHCP Annual Reviews and Personal budgets.

The trainers made us think hard about what preparation we could do to make the EHCP review constructive and useful for our children.

Many people on the course had limited knowledge around Personal Budgets, and the course clearly set out the duties and rationale behind their provision.

It was also good to network and share information with other attendees on the course.


16-19 Bursary Fund
