It will run from 3.15pm till 4.15pm, everything is supplied but we do ask that each child brings their own Tupperware, clearly named for the food to come home in.

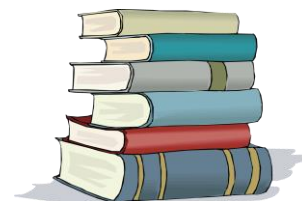
Letters will be sent out on Monday.
