### Oaks

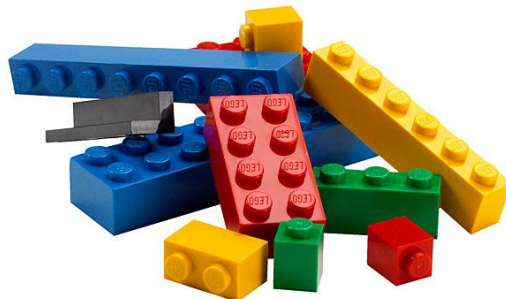
**Literacy:** This week we have been writing relative clauses and including these in a first person account of the Sorting Hat scene.
