Forest School Sessions at Ellingham Primary - Year 2 - Wednesday Afternoons

We are excited to be able to run a Forest School Programme for all of our pupils in 2019. Forest School is a type of outdoor education, which happens on a regular basis. As well as making and enriching curriculum links, the purpose of Forest School is to raise self-esteem, social skills and encourage team work. We aim to promote imaginative and creative play, independence and a caring attitude towards others and our environment whilst gaining valuable life skills. All sessions and activities are carefully planned, monitored and risk assessed.

A handbook with all of our risk assessments and policies in is available at school for anyone who wishes to view. Our programme will include a wide range of activities including crafts, environmental education, tool use, wood craft, den building, learning knots and campfire cookery.

Forest School Kit.
