learning about capacity and volume. Year 3 have been exploring, estimating and measuring the capacity of different containers. Year 4 have been converting between different units of measurement. Swifts have some homework to complete in relation to this.

In English Swifts have worked hard to plan and begin writing a recount about our wonderful Roman and Iceni day at Norwich Castle Museum. We have focused on writing in the past tense, using pronouns, using time connectives as fronted adverbials and paragraphs.
