Years 3 & 4 will be doing Forest Schools in the first half term when we return back in September. We still have outstanding consent forms, these must be returned by Wednesday this week.

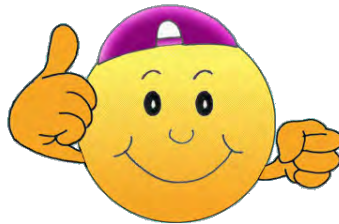


Leavers Assembly

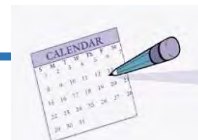

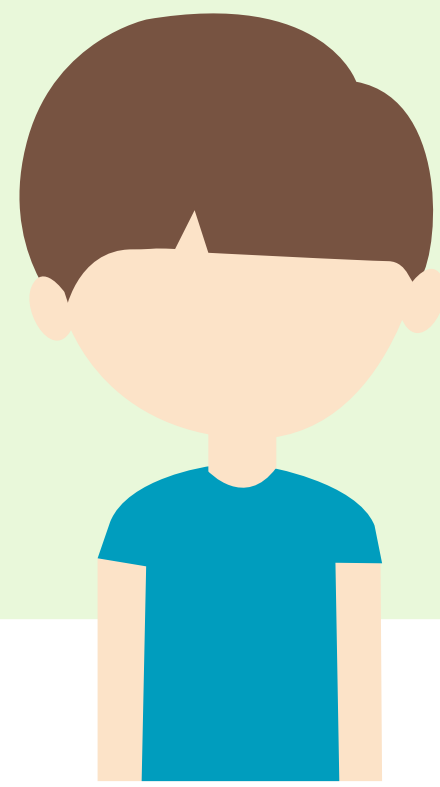

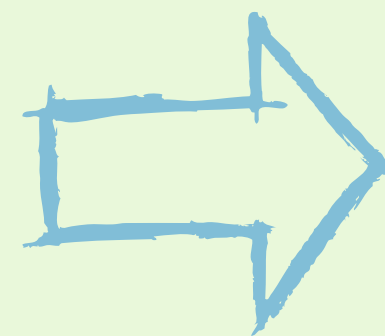

Nasal Flu Vaccine

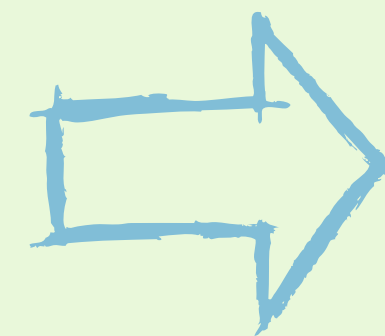
