Pupil Asset Parent App

Thank you to all of our parents/carers who have successfully downloaded the Pupil Asset Parent app. This app will allow you to book your child's school lunches, send permission for school trips and let you view your child's attendance.

Please ensure you download the app, if you haven't already done so, as we are using the information we receive from the parent app to book your child's school lunch. Please remember to input their choices, even if they are entitled to free school meals. You can book meals in advance and make changes, but the cut off is at 9am on the day.

We also need you to book your child's lunches in on a Monday for the whole week so that the kitchen knows what to prepare.

Please can you also make sure your child knows what lunch they are having as they are being asked in class every morning and we have had some children disagree with what has been booked in for them.

If you have any questions regarding the app, or are having difficulty downloading it, please speak to the school office.

The PTA, AGM will be on Friday 27th September, 7pm at Broome Artichoke. All are welcome to attend.

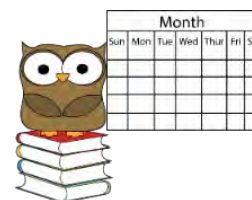

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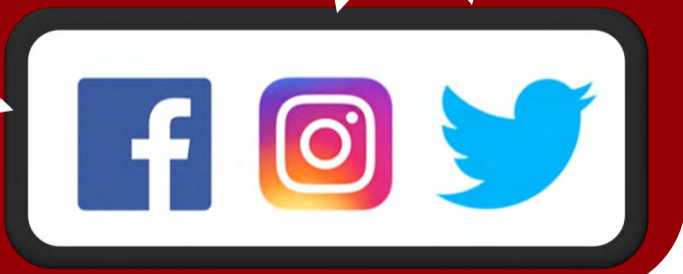

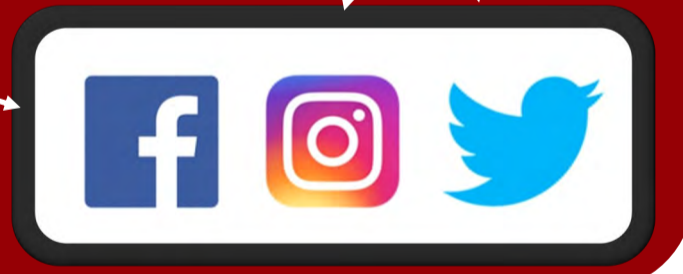
