Time Tables Olympics

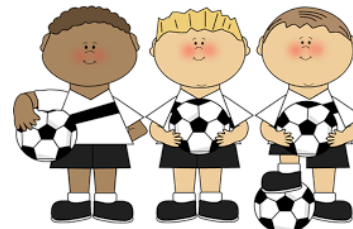
Congratulations to Barley for achieving level 1 and Jack for achieving Level 4 on the times table Olympics.
